The Tokyo Metropolitan Government offers free safety awareness seminars for children of foreign residents, among others.

To prevent children in Tokyo from engaging in delinquent behavior or becoming involved in crime or other trouble, **this course features dedicated instructors who clearly explain key points about life in Japan, using English or simple Japanese, drawing on recent real-life examples.**

Overview

Target audience: Elementary, junior high, and high school students attending international schools or Japanese language classes in Tokyo

*Sessions can be organized separately for elementary school students (lower and upper grades), junior high school students, and high school students. Small groups of about 7–8 students can also be accommodated.

Language: English or simple Japanese

Venue: A location in Tokyo specified by the applicant

*Please note that the applicant is responsible for arranging the venue.

Duration: Approximately 50 minutes.

*The duration **can be adjusted to between 30 and 60 minutes** upon request.

Format: In-person (online sessions via Zoom are also available)

*We will use the venue's projector and screen.

*The instructor will conduct the seminar using a PowerPoint presentation displayed on a PC.

Available: Until March 31, 2027

(Sessions can be arranged on weekends and holidays).

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Course outline

*Lecture duration is negotiable.
(Based on a 50-minute timeframe)

【Lecture content】

- 1) Basic crime prevention knowledge
(things to watch out for in public, etc.)
- 2) Introduction to manners and rules for living safely
- 3) Traffic safety
- 4) Preventing social media-related problems
- 5) Preventing delinquency
(bullying, shoplifting, drug abuse, etc.)

Application process

1. Submit a preliminary application via phone or email to the contact below

2. After receiving notification of date and time, fill out and return the application form sent by the Tokyo Metropolitan Government

If the session can be arranged, we will notify you of the date and time. We will also send you an application form.

Information to be included on the application form:

- (1) Preferred date and time for the event (2 options)
- (2) Venue (including equipment such as projectors and screens)
- (3) Target students (approximate number, grade level, language)
- (4) Selection of desired discussion topic
- (5) Other (whether you would like crime prevention advice from a police officer, availability of parking, and any other requests)

*Please note that the information provided on the application form will be shared with the instructor.

3. Final confirmation of content and equipment by the instructor

The instructor will contact you the day before the event to confirm the details of content and equipment.
